WHEREAS Rural Water District #17 in LeFlore County has a water loss ratio between 50-70% monthly due to poor installation of the water line 24 years ago that has depleted their resources; and there is danger of loss of water service for customers and

WHEREAS, Rural Water District #17 in LeFlore County is financially incapable of remedying the situation which threatens the public health and welfare of the people of Big Cedar, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, it is justifiable and in the best interest of the citizens of Big Cedar, Oklahoma, in LeFlore County, to expedite the preparation and submission of an application for financial assistance to resolve issues in the Pipe Springs area and seek a USDA Predevelopment Planning Grant for \$13,150.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a situation is hereby recognized and declared to exist in LeFlore County, Oklahoma and Vicki Cearnal, Chairperson of the Board, and/or Deborah Butler, Treasurer, are hereby authorized and directed to sign an application and related documents necessary to file and process the grant on behalf of the Rural Water District #17 in LeFlore County, Oklahoma, the 5<sup>th</sup> Day of August 2024.
